## Mission

San Martino Winery & Vineyards is an environmentally and socially conscious grower and producer of premium and ultra-premium wines. We achieve our mission by providing excellent value of all our products and by sharing the enjoyment of food and the wine lifestyle with our customers.

## History

The winery was the vision of owners Maria C. Perez and Emilio Ramos who in 2002 decided to purchase the land where it currently resides and build the initial winery building that houses the main tasting room. The winery opened its doors in the spring of 2004 with the release of its first vintage of Cabernet Sauvignon 2003. From a modest 650 cases for the first vintage to today's 6,000 plus cases, San Martino Winery & Vineyards has experienced success and growth because of the quality of service and products that brings to the market.

We are a small family-owned winery specializing in handcrafted wines using modern techniques but with a traditional "soul" borne in the fertile lands of northwestern Spain. During his formative years at the village of San Martiño located in the mountains of the Galician region of northern Spain, that Emilio Ramos's love and knowledge of wine and wine making techniques started. Through years of watching and helping his family in the vineyard, he came to appreciate the special relationship between people, land and the food they grow.

Our Texas winery was created by borrowing from the traditions of the San Martiño village and its people, the tenacity and resolution of our family and learned modern wine-making techniques while attending UC Davis enology program. Our heritage is rich and although we are not Texas largest winery, we aim to be the best winery in the Lone Star State.
